

## Art spaces in New Boquete library

All of these spaces have moldings

### 3<sup>rd</sup> floor Gallery

	Wid(ft)	height (ft)
Entry wall left	10	7 (~116" molding to top of floor molding)
Entry wall right	5	5?
window wall	12	7 (~98" " " )
back wall	33	7

New low wall to left as enter room—under windows. ~ 33 ft 5 ‘ high??? Not sure

Additional walls.

### On third floor:

Wall near door into gallery 2.5’ wide, 7’ high

Window wall opposite entry door = 10’ wide, 7 ‘ high

Adjacent wall 12’ “

Wall as coming up stairs (can have sun) ~ 10’ with 8-9’ molding, 7’ or more high

### 2<sup>nd</sup> floor

wall as coming up stairs- ~ 10’, molding ~ 8’) > 114 high.

Another wall to right as come up stairs (still lacking molding)

### 1<sup>st</sup> floor—

Rincon de arte—photography section includes 3 walls: 5’, 9’, 1.5’, each 4’ tall.

Front art wall (for donors?)

Wall by computers

Wall by windows

### TIPS

- We hang with fishing line which comes in different strengths and is nearly invisible
- Tie multiple knots—simple knots can slip with fishing line
- If possible, measure where you want the top of the painting and determine the amount of line needed. Tie it to painting before trying to hang it—its hard to tie when you are on a ladder holding the painting—
- For hanging artwork from molding attach the art to the line near the upper corners, if too far down the painting the top of painting will hang out from the wall.
